OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub: Guidelines and procedure for engagement of professional consultants in CSIR for centrally coordinated projects and activities in XII Five Year Plan

1. The Background

CSIR in XII Five Year Plan has taken up Centrally Coordinated Projects and activities such as Open Source Drug Discovery (OSDD); Traditional Knowledge Digital Library (TKDL); CSIR-800; Economic Impact Assessment of CSIR Technologies/ Products; Dissemination of CSIR's Knowledgebase and its achievements to people of India, Micro. Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) and Cluster Innovation Centers (CIC) etc. These projects and activities need diverse professional inputs which are not routinely available.

DG,CSIR has been pleased to approve the Guidelines and procedure for engagement of professional consultants, in view of foregoing. These guidelines are in accordance with the guidelines already in force for engagement of Professional Consultants by National Innovation Council (NInC) chaired by Advisor to Prime Minister on Public Information Infrastructure & Innovations. The details are given below:

2. The Guidelines and Operating Procedures

2.1 General Conditions for engaging Professional Consultants

- (a) Consultants will be engaged for providing high quality research and technical services or for attending to scientific and time-bound jobs like preparation of project reports, implementation plans etc. during XII Five Year Plan for centrally coordinated projects and activities.
- (b) Professionals with requisite qualifications and experience as prescribed in subsequent paras, will be hired, as Consultants. Retired Government employees, with requisite experience will also be eligible for selection as Consultants.
- (c) Maximum continuous engagement of a person as Consultant will be co-terminus with the XII Five Year Plan Period.
- (d) Consultants will be appointed on temporary (non-official) basis and the appointment may be cancelled, at any time without assigning any reason whatsoever.

2.2 Qualification of Consultants

Consultants will be professionals with academic qualifications. It Master's degree or above, in relevant subject area or having technical qualification such as B.Tech. MBA or equivalent relevant field/subject; with work experience in the resevant demonstrate Candidates with Ph.D., in relevant fields will have advantage

2.3 Categories of Consultants

- (a) Consultant A: Professionals with academic qualifications. Master's Degree or above, in relevant subject or lectronic qualifications such as B.Tech., MBA or equivalent in lelevant field/subject. They will be paid a consolidated real capquage from Rs. 20,000/- to Rs. 60,000/- per month.
- (b) Consultant B: Professionals with academic qualification Master's Degree or above, in relevant subject or technical qualifications such as B.Tech., MBA or equivalent or Ph.D. or area relevant field/subject; with work experience or the domain of minimum 5-6 years. They will be paid conspication fee, ranging from Rs. 40,000/- to Rs. 90,000/- per month.

Consultant B may also be recruited to advice the conscious General in various policy matters. Candidates making and in box thinking on policy issues focused on research work with be accorded priority.

2.4 Period of engagement of Consultants

Consultants will be appointed on temporary (non-official basis and the appointment may be cancelled, at any time by USIF, without assigning any reason whatsoever. Initial appointment will be for the year and may be renewed on the basis of performance evaluation by the duly constituted committee by DG, CSIR. The appointment of Consultant, can be terminated by CSIR, without assigning and reason whatsoever, by giving one month notice

2.5 Procedure for selection of Consultants

The Consultants will be selected on the basis of interview pendented by a board, especially constituted for the purpose by the DG OSIR Vacancy of Consultants will be hosted on the OSIR Website or respective project's website and will be published in one retional newspaper.

2.6 Library facility and leave period for the Consultants selected

(a) Library Facility: The consultants shall have access to me CSIR Library, during period of consultancy and will be

allowed to borrow books, as per Library Rules subject to the condition that the last months salary will be paid only upon receipt of no objection certificate (NOC) from the library.

(b) Leave: Consultants will be entitled to 8 days leave in one calendar year or any pro-rata basis. Depending on period of Consultancy, leave beyond this entitlement will be on "no fee" basis, but un-availed entitled leave cannot be carried forward to the next calendar year. CSIR will be free to terminate consultancy in case of absence of Consultant, of more than 15 days, beyond entitled leave in one calendar year.

2.7 Other facilities to Consultants

Consultants for their professional work during the engagement with CSIR would be provided all necessary facilities such as Laptops, Identity Card etc.

2.8 TA/DA and accommodation to Consultants

Consultants will be entitled for TA/DA for their travel within India, as is admissible to Central Government officers with Grade Pay of Rs 8700/-.

3. The consultancy will not entitle the concerned person to any claim of Government service and/or CSIR service, in any manner.

4. Implementation of the Guidelines

These guidelines and operating procedures shall come into effect from the date of issue of this Office Memorandum.
